ABOUT OUR ORGANIZATION

Flash back

Joint Endeavour for Emancipation Training & Action for women (JEETA), as not for profit organizations, commenced its journey during the year 1994 due to the inexorable efforts of a handful of young women with social work bent of mind and dedication to work for the underprivileged in the remote villages of Anugul and Deogarh Districts where the development is in the nascent stage.

The journey made so far

JEETA basically evolved especially to work in the issue of domestic violence. Gradually in the process of maturing, it has to be involved with broad spectrum of developmental issues focusing on Livelihood, Health, Water Sanitation & Hygiene, Migration, Local Self Governance and Gender Discrimination.

Legal Status

It got registered under Societies Registration Act of 1860 bearing No.19589/21 during the year 1994-95. Subsequently was registered under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act bearing the number 104850007 during September 2003. JEETA has also obtained the registration under 12 A & 80 G of the Income Tax Act during 2007 as well as PAN card no. AAAAJ3195Q and TAN BBNJ00598D for fulfilling the tax formalities.

Office locations

Currently JEETA has its Head Office located at Pallahara of Anugul District and established its project office in Prakrutipalli of Barkote block of Anugul District.


Approach

Our governance system

Bye-law of JEETA as empowered General Body as the supreme authority with Governing Body (Board) in down the line, constituted with 5 office bearers headed by the Chairperson. The other office bearers of the Board include Vice Chairperson, Secretary, Asst. Secretary and Treasurer. The Secretary acts as the Chief of the organization, responsible for day-to-day functioning as well as for programme implementation being helped by Programme/project staff and Treasurer for Finance & Administration. The Bye-law of the organization is there which elaborates the role and functional modalities of General Body, Office bearers and other members for effective governance of the organization. The Board meeting is usually conducted twice a year to review the progress and decide further course of action. The Annual General Meeting is conducted once in every year taking all members to approve operational plan, budget, review the accomplishments and take major policy decisions.

OUR PROGRAMMES

Considering the local level issues and problems, JEETA has continued to intensify its effort on the sectors of Livelihood, Water, Health & Sanitation and Women Empowerment along with capacity building of the target communities within the broad framework of our vision and mission.

The major accomplishments during the year 2020-2021 are succinctly articulated below

Enhancing food & nutritional security:

Agriculture is one of the major contributors to the family income of the inhabitants of the target population. However over the last decade it is observed that this sector is not yielding good returns due to many reasons such as: climatic change hazards, erratic and inadequate monsoon, decreasing soil fertility etc. As a result the problems of food insecurity and reduce of income are growing high.

JEETA has been continuing an innovative initiative in 27 villages of Barkote of Debagarh dist & 21 villages of Pallahara Block of Angul district

Angul District since 2009 where the method System of Rice Intensification (SRI) is introduced among

lead farmers. As they have done in last year this also the SRI process in rice,ragi,wheat & vegetable. Also the women farmers are continuing the nonfarm activities on goatry & poultry in individual level .

In Pallahara & Barkote block the farmers of marginaliged comunity continue there practice on rice, wheat, pulses & millets usinging organic manure. Most of the tribal families of Pallahara & Barkote blocks depend upon the rain water to do any farm work so they do the millet & small variety paddy in the dry land.

Instead of the COVID 19 pandamic situation people tried their best to continue the farm activities.

After rice they do the vegetable cultivation for their counsumption & selling.

CHILDLINE Angul-Sub-Centre Pallahara-

The CHILDLINE1098 24x7 emergency service for children the scheme of Ministry of Women & Child Development Department has been started in Pallahara block with the partnership & support of CHILDLINE India Foundation

This program was formaly inaugurated by Sri Ajit Kumar Pradhan Sub-Collector Pallahara .Now the emergency service for children in need care & prtection are provide by the CHILDLINE team of JEETA.





Research study on impact of Covid19 on children's learning and child protection in odisha in collaboration with OSCPCR.

JEETA has been done a mobile app research study on impact of Covid 19 Pandmic on children's learning,& child protection in Odisha with the children,parents,teacher,BDO,BEO & Sub- Collector .Which was enrich the knowledge to know more about the vulnerability of the children on their study.About 80% of the children are from remote village who have not the access of mobile, electricity & good environment to study in their house .

AWARENESS Generation on COVID-19 in Grass root Level

JEETA has been created awareness among the community people on Covid 19

status & the preventive measures involving PRI members Teacher, School committee members & the SHG leaders in different parts of Barkote & Pallahara Block.



Campaign on Destination Unknown

Mass campaign has been made in four villages of Pallahara Block to sensitization children and their parents on potential risks in job/work sites, child safeguarding & protection measures to be undertaken, Early mirage prohibition Act, Juvenile justice Act etc with the support of CARD Bhubaneswar. There are four villages are taken where most of the children go to outside for searching of work. Regular village level meeting, interface with district & block level officials involvement of local governance is going on. Most of the children who were migrated to Chenai & Hydrabad are in difficult situation due to pandemic.

I. Enabling the target communities to access safe improved water, sanitation & hygiene (wash) facilities

This year the Participatory Rural Appraisal has been made in 215 villages of 10 GPs of Barkote block & the findings shared with the Sarpanch & Block officials & lobby with them how to incorporate the plans in the plan of action of the Panchayat & Blocks.

The habitation level Water user committees have been set up in 29 villages, The committee consists of SHG mothers, AWW, AHSA, Cadres and PRI members. Each village / habitation has 15 to 20 members, and they will be responsible for providing clean water to every family. The committee has decided to do the following activity.

- 1. All the formed committee are collecting user fee as per required for O&M of MPWS
- 2. 7 committee has been opened bank account in the name of water user committee
- 3. All committees are able to obtain the required grants from local Gram

Water Security: -

The decision was made to turn the hill-forested village into a model village where people had been using spring water for years. Pacheripani village Kaliapal GP,Khunntadihi village ofSaruali GP & Katei of Bamparada GP of Barkote block where tribal families live . Now these families are getting house hold connection pipe water supply with the support of WaterAid & Gram Panchayat Kaliapal & PBDA

In view of this problem, the decision was made to install water supply to every household with the help of Water Aid and JEETA started work in collaboration with the local GP PBDA. By end of March 2021 all the families access to safe drinking water in their homes.

I. Capacity building of the statkeholders:







Considering the health situation of the target area and recognizing that health care givers & service providers are instrumental to bring positive changes effort of capacity building of the caregivers has been continued. With the assistance of National Health Mission (NHM), Deogarh, the community leaders especially Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA) are capacitated to upgrade their knowledge and skills for providing better services in the village level Barkote, Tileibani & Riamal Block of Deogarh District.


